WHAT TO EXPECT

Bali is packed with attractions. This tour takes you to a range of the island's best and most popular hotspots, including waterfalls, ancient temples, sacred natural springs, royal tombs, and spectacular volcano views. Get a full overview of what makes Bali so magical.



WHAT YOU WILL DO

At roughly 8:00 AM, your morning pick-up takes you early towards the towering Tegenungan waterfall. After a quick hike and a dip in cool waters, you will be taken to a holy water temple, a sacred temple and natural spring. The journey continues to the next holy site of Gunung Kawi, located in a valley with impressive views of rice fields at its entrance. Next, lunch at a Lakeview Restaurant (or similar) greets you with a view of Mount Batur, a live volcano and otherworldly lava flows on the flanks of the mountain. The day ends at one of Bali's most iconic landscapes, Tegalalang rice terraces.

THE HEART OF BALI

WHAT TO EXPECT

This tour takes you into the breadbasket of Bali, where vistas of green paddies blanket the landscape. You will visit a temple on the slopes of a volcano; get first hand experience walking through a UNESCO World Heritage Site; dip into the steamy hot springs while enjoying the best sunset views of Bali.



WHAT YOU WILL DO

Following the pick up at 8:00 AM, your first stop will be Tanah Lot, the birthplace of Balinese Hinduism in the ancient temple, perched on the top of a rocky outcrop amidst crashing waves. Continuing on, discover the authenticity of a typical market in the city of Tabanan. Then on the slopes of Mt. Batukaru (Bali's second-highest volcano, 2,270 m above sea level), is where you will then find the great temple dedicated to the deity Mahadewa of the West. Closeby, are the rice fields of Jatiluwih – a UNESCO World Heritage Site – for your tailored lunch experience at Gong Jatiluwih. Just down the road, Penatahan volcanic hot springs ends the day of amazing scenery, after a luxurious dip into nature, before returning to the hotel.

VOLCANO TOUR

WHAT TO EXPECT

Discover spectacular landscapes and volcanic springs surrounding Bali's Mt. Batur, an active volcano part of UNESCO's Global Geoparks Network. This full-day tour combines a range of natural wonders and new-and-improved experiences in nature, such as the hot springs of Lake Batur, traditional delicacies and hidden waterfalls within forested canyons.



WHAT YOU WILL DO

At roughly 8:00 AM, your hotel pick up is a vintage VW convertible, bridging you to Mt. Batur's surroundings (a 1,717 m or 5,633 ft stratovolcano located in the Bangli Regency). Jump into the soothing hot springs on the shores of Lake Batur, before driving up to the Lakeview Restaurant (or similar) for a lunch accompanied by amazing views. Complete the adventure at Tukad Cepung waterfall, secluded in the greenery and illuminated by slivers of the afternoon sun at the roof of the forest canyon.



WHAT TO EXPECT

Home to artisanal goods, sacred sites and secluded beaches, Bali's Eastern shore is a feast for the eyes and a treat for explorers. This full-day tour takes you to serene water temples, authentic local restaurants and the quiet white sand beach of Karangasem.



WHAT YOU WILL DO

Following your hotel pick-up at 6:45 AM, the North-Eastern side of the Karangasem region will be your starting point. The first stop will be the Lempuyang Temple (also known as the Gates of Heaven). Next, comes Tirta Gangga, where one discovers the importance of holy water in Balinese Hinduism and daily life. Lunch ensues at Dewata Agung Restaurant (or similar), where exquisite Balinese dishes are served in the peaceful setting of lush gardens and fish ponds. Then, you will head towards Taman Ujung Water Palace, where you will discover this ancient relic of architectural expertise, built upon the expanse of water. Rest under the Balinese sun among breathtaking views of the secluded Virgin Beach at the end of the day.

NORTH OF BALI

WHAT TO EXPECT

The full-day tour introduces you to the beauty, spirituality and history of Bali's northern regions. Here, you will find a floating temple at one of Bali's main lakes; a serene Buddhist monastery; a mountain-top restaurant and a pair of spectacular waterfalls cascading into a single pool.



WHAT YOU WILL DO

Following your hotel pick-up at 8:00 AM, journey to the Ulun Danu Bratan temple, an eleven-tiered pagoda built on an island in the lake. Next, the Twin Lake Viewpoint, and Banyumala Waterfall and the Ngiring Ngwedang Restaurant (or similar), all perched on top of a mountain, 1,200 m above sea-level, awaits. Each site holds breathtaking views overlooking the Banjar district in the Buleleng regency. A visit to the Brahma Vihara Arama Buddhist Monastery, is completed at the Banjar Hot Springs, situated in the jungle by the tropical gardens of Lovina Beach.

This tour introduces you to traditional, rural, ways of life in an old Balinese village. You will visit a local school; explore a heritage house; form your own sacred daily offerings and take a walk in the village's rice fields in discovery of the region's farming techniques.



WHAT YOU WILL DO

The hotel pick-up at roughly 8:00 AM will take you to Taman Sari Buwana, a cooperative farm in the Tabanan regency. Here, one finds scenic farmland and a well-preserved lifestyle where as many as 15 families live harmoniously within one compound. Fields are ploughed by buffaloes and rice is picked by hand. Find tropical fruit plantations, orchards and spice gardens, as well as the occasion to learn more about age-old ways of farming.



Finish the day exploring the ancient courts of Kerta gosa before returning to the hotel.

Discover the rice terraces of Pakudui and sit on a swing for a unique souvenir shot with a view of the surrounding nature.

Here, you will learn the natural irrigation system of Subak farming. Try your hand at local handicrafts before a historical temple-visit.



WHAT YOU WILL DO

The hotel pick-up at around 8:00 AM will bring you on a journey to Tibumana and Pengibul waterfalls for a fresh start in the water. Next, you will visit Bali countryside, Bali's leading eco-tourism centre. Here, you will have the chance to take on a cooking class; plough the fields with a buffalo like locals do; as well as practice traditional Balinese Sanskrit calligraphy in the shadows of Bali's most sacred volcano, Mt. Agung. Enjoy an organic picnic lunch in the fields, before continuing onto Pura Kehen: a thirteenth-century royal temple built by the hands of the ancient Bangli Kingdom.

THE OTHER SIDE OF UBUD

WHAT TO EXPECT

Ubud is renowned as Bali's capital of arts and culture. This full-day tour takes you deeper into the region's creative, spiritual and natural heritage. You will visit picturesque ancient temples, explore jungles and barter for handicrafts at the local market, uncovering a glimpse of Ubud's allure.



WHAT YOU WILL DO

Hotel pick up at 8:00 AM will take you to the morning show of the Barong dance, depicting the endless battle between good (Barong) and evil (Rangda), of which goodness eternally prevails. Continue onto Goa Gajah (literally, 'elephant cave') to discover its age-old frescoes, meditational cave, ponds and fountains frequented historically by Hindu monks. Following a tasty lunch at Green Puri Suling (or similar), journey onwards to Ubud's Monkey Forest, home to long-tailed macaques and several holy temples within its forest. Lastly, Pura Taman Saraswati otherwise known as the Water Palace, greets its passers-by with her extensive lotus pond, dedicated to the goddess of knowledge. The day ends amidst the colours and crafts of the Ubud Market.



DENPASAR CITY TOUR

Bali's main museum, architecture and artistry in action is not to be missed, displayed within its art centres and temples, a silent guardian over Denpasar's vibrant atmosphere.

Starting at 8:00 AM from your hotel, you will be visiting the Kumbasari Traditional Market, where 200 kiosks and 1,000 stalls are packed with daily essentials. Then, the Museum of Bali, established in 1932, greets you with a collection of paintings, woodcarvings, masks, leather puppets and hand-woven textiles. A short ride will then take you to the Bajra Sandhi Monument, Jagatnatha Temple and the Werdi Budaya Art Centre. Here, you will find the location of the annual Bali Arts Festival at Bajra Sandhi. End the day with the historic Niti Mandala Monument, a symbol of Balinese liberation from the Dutch during the years of colonial rule.

TANAH LOT SUNSET

WHAT TO EXPECT

One of Bali's most iconic sites, Tanah Lot is the birthplace of Balinese Hinduism, an ancient temple which remains a place of great importance. This half-day tour combines up-close wildlife observations with spiritual discovery at a sacred temple, followed by unforgettable sunsets at Tanah Lot.



WHAT YOU WILL DO

From 1:30 PM at the hotel, your day begins at Sangeh Monkey Forest, a 13-hectare natural reserve home to 22 bird species, best known for its monkey kingdom tucked within. Next, the Taman Ayun Temple, built by the ancient Mengwi kingdom in 1634 welcomes you to its sacred shrine dedicated to its ancestors. The tour rounds off at Tanah Lot, the birthplace of Balinese Hinduism in the ancient temple, perched on the top of a rocky outcrop. Here, feast your eyes on ethereal sunset views while walking through restaurants and shops at the cultural park.



KECAK DANCE AT ULUWATU

WHAT TO EXPECT

This half-day tour introduces you to Bali's spectacular Kecak dance, performed at the island's sacred Uluwatu temple in an amphitheatre overlooking the Indian Ocean. Combining traditional dance, drama, mythology and mysticism, this magical experience of a fiery spectacle takes place over a picturesque sunset.



WHAT YOU WILL DO

In the afternoon, your 3:00 PM hotel pick-up will take you to the temple in Uluwatu on the southern tip of Bali. Here, the cliff-top temple grounds provide the best viewpoint to admire the glistening ocean sunset, before the evening's performance of the famous Kecak dance. A rendition of the Hindu Ramayana, the main plot reverberates similarly throughout Southeast Asia, to its unique cultural expressions of the region's own 'Romeo & Juliet'. Combining theatre and exorcism rituals, this spectacle is an esoteric celebration of prevailing good.
